Letter from the #1

Brothers,

The last several months have been eventful ones for Alpha Iota, with this year's recruitment of two strong pledge classes, high live-in numbers, and the hosting of Chi Psi's Midwest Rowe Regional Conference.

Recruitment

Interest in Greek life at the University of Wisconsin has grown in recent semesters, so it follows that our pledge classes have been gradually increasing in size as well. This past fall we welcomed 20 fine gentlemen into the bonds of Chi Psi and our spring recruitment netted 15 new members who we hope to activate in a few weeks' time. While we recruit based solely on the merits of one's character, we pride ourselves on how diverse and well-rounded our Brotherhood has become, with Brothers studying a wide range of subjects and hailing from cities in all regions of the country. While our Fraternity slowly increases in size and number, we remain cognizant of the importance of retaining the tight-knit nature of our Brotherhood.

Living In

We have 27 Brothers living in the Lodge this semester and anticipate sustaining live-in numbers in the mid 30's for the foreseeable future. As I explained the value of living in to potential new members during the recruitment period, I found myself realizing the extent to which living in the Lodge has enriched my college experience and brought me closer to the Brothers with whom I have lived. I look forward to the capital campaign bestowing upon the Lodge an environment in which this tradition may thrive for decades to come.

Alpha Iota's Second Century Campaign Endow the Lodge, Invest in Our Future.

Campaign Concluding–Recognition Wall to Hang in Lodge

The Second Century Campaign for Alpha Iota, "Endow the Lodge, Invest in Our Future" – will conclude at Homecoming, 2016. We invite all Lodgers to attend this momentous celebration.

A donor recognition wall will be hung in the Lodge, recognizing lifetime contributors to the Iota Court Preservation Foundation, the 50I(c)(3) that was established in 1987 to receive and manage funds for the long term renovation and restoration of our historic Lodge at 150 Iota Ct.

During the course of the campaign, we were fortunate to have Bill Walker Sr. and Bill Walker Jr. providing leadership and motivation. Their dedication to the Lodge has remained steadfast and their contributions are many. We offer a very special thanks to them for their efforts.

The latest campaign, our fourth in as many decades, raised just over \$1 million from just 74 Lodgers. On the positive side, once the funds are all collected, we will have funds from one-time gifts and multi-year pledges to retire the renovations loans from much-needed improvements made more than a decade ago. On the downside, only 7.6% of all living Lodgers supported the campaign. We currently count 973 living Lodgers from Alpha Iota. The results beg the question: Is it fair that such a small minority of our alumni are responsible for the long term care of our beloved Lodge?

The Lodge is was built in 1912. It is now more than a century old, and it has housed and nurtured generations of young men who have lived at Iota Court. Life long friendships were made under its roof. Memorable events occurred there, from formal pledge ceremonies to social events, summers on the pier, and dinner conversations that still echo through the hallways. It has always been there for us — a constant part of our past in an ever-changing world.

We can never go back to those days when we were young college students and active members of Alpha Iota, but we can pay it forward for the next generation. We want them to enjoy the same experiences as we did in the Lodge. Alumni who came before us provided that same support for the Lodge that we so much enjoyed

When we unveil the Recognition Wall on November 12, 2016, I hope we will be able to add YOUR NAME to the list of those who came before us, and those who will follow, with your support of the Lodge. 
